What's inside a Safe Injection Kit?

Sterile Syringeprovides a clean tool for injection



Cotton-Acts as a sterile filter to catch the drugs that don't dissolve

Sterile Water- Clean source for mixing drugs for injection



Tourniquet-Helps with finding a vein and keeping the vein plump for injection

Alcohol Pads-Helps clean the injection site on the skin, preventing bacterial infections



Cooker-Acts as a clean place to mix and heat the substance for injection

Why Safe Injection Kits & programs are important

Reduce transmission of HIV and Hepatitis C infections by encouraging people not to share needles & tools

Using safe sterile tools for injection paired with education around safer injection can help reduce chances of

- -abscesses -blood infections -vein damage
- scars/ track marks

These programs act as a bridge to other health services:

- HIV & Hep C testing and treatment
- Vaccinations
- Substance use treatment

They provide a safe way for disposing of used syringes
